Free Services and Supplies to Flint Residents

Help Centers serve as a “one-stop shop” offering **FREE** resources for Flint residents including lead-fighting foods and produce.

Where are the Help Centers?

Three centers are located in Flint

Asbury Church, 1653 Davison Rd- close to the Franklin Bus Route 7 (Davison Rd. and Franklin Rd.)

Bethel United Methodist Church, 1309 N Ballenger Hwy – close to Beecher/Corunna Bus Route 12 (Ballenger Hwy and Flushing Rd)

Greater Holy Temple Church of God in Christ, 6702 N Dort Hwy – close to the Crosstown North Bus Route 13 (Carpenter Rd and Dort Hwy)

When are the Help Centers open?

Help centers are open Monday thru Thursday from 10:00 am – 4:30pm each day

Who is eligible to go to the Help Centers?

All Flint residents. Services are free and there is no eligibility criteria to receive services.

What do I need to bring with me to the Help Center?

Nothing. Help Centers do not ask for any personal information. You do not need any personal documentation. You will be ask for your zip code and household count by age.

How often can I visit the Help Centers?

Residents are invited to visit the Help Centers one time per day.

Can I pick up items for my neighbor/family members residing in Flint?

Yes. Items may be picked up for a neighbor/family member residing in Flint as long as their zip code and household count by age is provided.

What kinds of personal needs items are at the Help Centers?

Toothpaste, toothbrushes, diapers, shampoo and other personal need items.

What kinds of food are at the Help Centers? Boxed dinners, canned meat, canned vegetables, pasta, peanut butter, jelly, cereal, fresh apples, potatoes and carrots.
